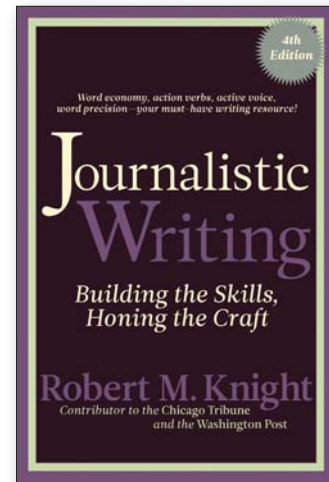
## A Handwritten Modern Classic

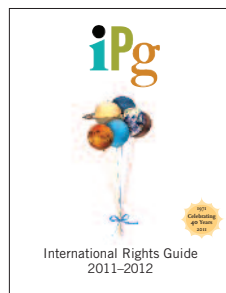
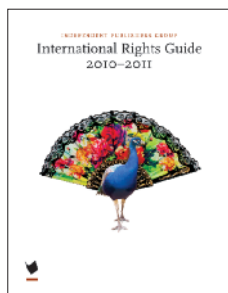
